- b) Are you watching any indicators?
- c) Are you expecting interruptions?
- d) Have you written down what hasn't worked so far?
- e) Have you asked anyone for help?
- f) Do you have a list of what's confusing or missing at the moment?

g) Any other questions or observations?

"Stuck" may be genuine, deciding, judging, interpreting, challenging or structuring the project's flow.
