PCB Design Workshop

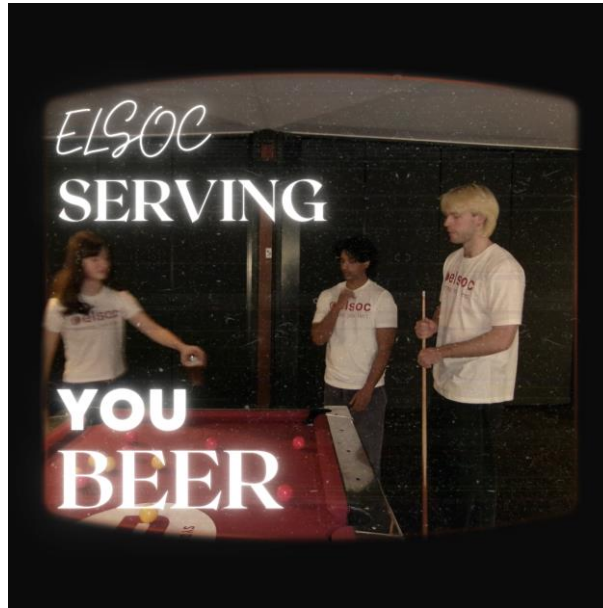


Part 1: Week 4 Thursday, 10am - 12pm, EET 201
