If you feel like ELEC1111 has been making you run in loops, well then, the sum of your voltages must be zero.

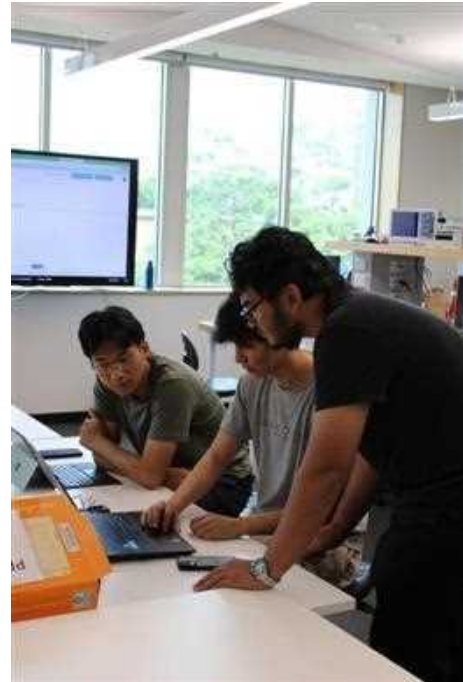
Join UNSW PASS mentors and our team of societies to consolidate everything you've learned in ELEC1111 this term.
